Consultation response

The LCC fully supports the far more detailed responses to both consultations by our local groups, the City of London Cycling Campaign and Cycle Islington. Both schemes are supported, with caveats.

For the Beech Street scheme, primarily, the scheme should be urgently extended at both ends, particularly the junction with Aldersgate Street, the Golden Lane junction needs further improvements and there is a risk that as use of electric vehicles rises, the scheme's restrictions will need tightening.

For the Bunhill, Barbican & Golden Lane scheme, a full "Low Traffic Neighbourhood" (LTN) should be proposed and implemented removing all through motor traffic from the area and further calming motor traffic beyond that. Main roads at the edge of the area should also be urgently considered for improvements and crossings.
